

From November 2022, the COVID-19 vaccine will be replaced by Pfizer's vaccine targeting Omicron variant (BA.4/5). Currently, the bivalent vaccine targeting Omicron variant is administered once per person, regardless of the number of doses or type of vaccine (BA.1 or BA.4/5).



Those who have already been vaccinated against Omicron variant (BA.1) should not be vaccinated against Omicron variant (BA.4/5).

Since the interval between the 3rd, 4th, and 5th doses has been shortened from 5 months to 3 months



new vaccination coupons will be sent sequentially from November 1 to those who are eligible for vaccination.

COVID-19 vaccine for children ages 6 months to 4 years will be available. It is given in three doses, and an application from the parent or guardian is required for the issuance of the vaccination coupon.



COVID-19 vaccines are available until March 31, 2023. Since the bivalent vaccine targeting Omicron variant cannot be administered unless 1st and 2nd doses of the primary vaccination series have been completed, those who wish to receive the vaccine should consider completing the 1st and 2nd doses by the end of the year (within 2022).
